

# Literary Translator in Residence

The School of Languages, Literatures and Cultures, University College Cork in partnership with Literature Ireland, seek applications from literary translators from Spain for a residential bursary in Cork.

In 2020, we will award one bursary of ten weeks' duration. The bursary will be awarded to a practising literary translator who is working on the translation into Spanish of a work of contemporary Irish literature.

Travel and living expenses will be covered by Literature Ireland, while accommodation and a work space will be provided by the School of Languages, Literatures and Cultures, University College Cork. The successful candidate will be asked to work on their translation-in-progress, to immerse themselves in Cork's rich literary and cultural life and to hold one public event near the end of their stay, focusing on their translation work.

The bursary will run from mid-June until the end of August. Applications should include:

- an outline project proposal;
- current curriculum vitae and two references (including one from a publishing house located in a Spanish-speaking country);
- proof that the applicant holds a publishing contract for the translation of a work of contemporary Irish literature into Spanish;
- a sample of the translation-in-progress (approximately 1,000 words of the source text, plus a draft translation).
